## What You'll Receive

- ✔ **3 90-minute virtual workshop sessions** that will guide organizations through a five-step process for scenario planning, including concrete examples and space for participants to begin to put concepts into practice
- ✔ **Up to 3 hours of coaching** support to help leaders work through the steps of the scenario-planning process in between workshop sessions and offer guidance on the creation of a scenario plan.
- ✔ **Frameworks and tools** to support scenario planning and monitoring
- ✔ Participants will leave with a **completed scenario plan** that explores possible scenarios related to 2-3 drivers that could impact the organization. They also will leave with the **capacity and knowledge to repeat this process on their own.**
- ✔ **Funders and nonprofit networks** purchasing the offering will receive a **summary report** that describes how the workshops and coaching helped participating organizations.
